

# W Home Visitor Volunteer Role Profile

Title: Home Visitor Volunteer

Responsible to: Adoption Officer, Foster Care Coordinator and the Volunteering &

Foster Caring Manager

Location: Mayhew Trenmar Gardens and other locations throughout London

#### **Overview**

Home Visitor Volunteers are an essential part of the rehoming/fostering process. To ensure all adopter and foster carer homes are safe and suitable, we ask our home visitor volunteers to visit the home of those wanting to adopt/foster. You will be required to fill out a form which you will need to send back to Mayhew via email. All adopters and foster carers will also require a post home visit to ensure everything is going well.

#### **Main Duties**

- To carry out effective pre and post home visits.
- To verify the information gathered within the adoption/foster interview by the CAO or Volunteer & Foster Caring Manager.
- To interpret and apply Mayhew re-homing guidelines.
- To promote responsible pet ownership.
- To act as our eyes and ears in the home.
- To feedback concerns or problems with any pre or post home visits to the CAO.
- To respect Mayhew decisions and advice on re-homing/fostering animals

#### **Feedback**

To provide feedback to the Adoption Officer, Foster Care Coordinator or Volunteering & Foster Caring Manager about how the home visit went using a structured form.

# **Time Commitment Required**

- Minimum commitment 6 months
- It is entirely dependant on the availability of each home visitor how many home visits they wish to do.
- Once agreed to carry out a home visit, contacting the adopter/foster carer within 48 hours to schedule a home visit.
- An induction to this role will be necessary. The induction usually take no more than 2 hours.

#### **Dress Code**

 Be mindful of wearing jewellery and open toe shoes when doing post home visit checks, as these can be health and safety hazards around animals. **Skills/Qualifications Required** 

- Ability to work as part of a team and follow instructions
- A commitment to the work of Mayhew and our policies
- Trustworthy and reliable
- Knowledge of basic Cat and or Dog behaviours required.
- Confident using a computer (emails and filling in word documents)

- Opportunity to meet and learn from new people with similar interests
- Become involved in the community
- Apply personal skills and experiences to help in a positive way
